Brief History

The Fort Dodge Public Library was designed by Durrant Architects and constructed by Woodruff Construction in 2000. Continued maintenance is vital in keeping the Library in good condition and code compliant. In September 2013, as part of the 2013 streetscape maintenance projects, City Council approved the Library Square Street Light Painting Project.

Staff has evaluated the lighting in the main area of the library. The lighting is very uneven throughout this area, with hot spots and then many dark spots with very little available light. The globe lighting is difficult to maintain and expensive to replace. Replacing the lighting with LED fixtures will add more light to the shelving areas and provide a nice focus area for displays. The Engineer's Estimate of Cost for this project is \$190,000.

A bid letting date of May 15^{th} , 2014 and a public hearing date of May 27^{th} , 2014 were set by Council on April 28^{th} , 2014.

Analysis of Issue

Staff received one responsive bid on May 15th, 2014 from Bemrich Electric and Telephone INC and had to turn one irresponsive bid away due to the lack of an accompanying 5% Bid Bond. Bemrich's bid was for: \$173,203.65, nearly \$17,000 less than estimated.

Budget Impact

This project will be funded from the Gwen Scharfenburg Library Donation. The money donation from Gwen Scharfenburg is invested by the Fort Dodge Library Foundation, and administered by the Library Board.

Strategic Plan Impact

Policy D.4.2: Advanced planning for all facilities shall be supported and routinely updated. Facilities benefited by advanced planning shall include, at minimum, libraries,



schools, health care, residential areas, roads, water, sewer, storm water management, parks, recreation, and greenways.

Impact on Existing Plans

This project has been approved by the Fort Dodge Public Library Foundation and Library Board.

Staff Conclusions / Recommendations

It is our recommendation to award the contract to Bemrich Electric and Telephone INC in the amount of \$173,203.65.

No additional City Council action shall be required to approve the executed Contract or Surety Bonds, unless requested by the City Attorney.

Section IV. The amount of the Contractor's Performance and/or Payment Bonds is hereby fixed and determined to be 100% of the amount of the Contract.
