Brief History

In 1967, the City acquired property for the Veteran's Bridge Project. There remains a residual piece of property that was not needed for the project. The adjacent property owner has requested that he be allowed to purchase this property in order to combine it with his existing property. The adjacent owner has been maintaining this property since he purchased the adjacent property in 1997 including mowing, fertilizing and snow removal (see attached letter).

Analysis of Issue

Disposing of this property would put it back on the tax rolls and allow the adjacent owners to expand the site of their business, East Lawn Animal Hospital.

Budget Impact

The adjacent property owners, Michael and Tina Bottorff, have offered \$250 to purchase this parcel.

The general fund would realize income from the taxes generated from this property.

Strategic Plan Impact

Policy D.4.2: Advanced planning for all infrastructure facilities shall be supported and routinely updated. Facilities benefited by advanced planning shall include, at minimum, schools, health care, residential areas, roads, water, sewer, storm water management, parks, recreation, and greenways.
