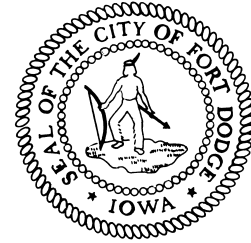

Analysis of Issue

The City established the Recycling Fund (675) to pay for the small blue recycling baskets. Since the new recycling program eliminated the use of the blue recycling baskets, and is now established and maintained through our Solid Waste Fund (670), it is the recommendation of our auditor to close the Recycling Fund's cash on hand as of June 30, 2014 (currently at \$58,065.13) into the Solid Waste Fund.
