**Payment to Mid-American to Relocate Utility Poles**

## **Brief History**

The Snyder and Associates, INC has prepared the plans and specifications for the Menards Traffic Signal Project & 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue South Corridor Improvements. The project includes installation of the 5<sup>th</sup> Ave. S. & east Menards driveway intersection signals, to convert 5<sup>th</sup> Ave. S. from east of S. 32<sup>nd</sup> St. to S. 42<sup>nd</sup> St./P-59 to a 3-lane roadway, and to install a right turn lane from 5<sup>th</sup> Ave. S. into the west Menards driveway. On December 9th, 2013 Council approved setting bid letting date to receive bids for this project on January 14<sup>th</sup>, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. A public hearing was set to approve the plans and specifications, form of contract, and estimate of costs for January 27<sup>th</sup>, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. The following responsive bid was received:

Contractor	Bid Amount
Fort Dodge Asphalt	\$575,200.60

Engineer's Estimate for this project is \$506,000.00. Council awarded a contract to Fort Dodge Asphalt on January 27th, 2014.

Approved on May 27, 2014, Change Order #1 was necessary for two reasons: First, moving Ziegler's entrance to the east of their existing entrance will provide more space between the entrance and the traffic lights that will allow Ziegler's traffic to get in and out easier. Second, the entrance will now align with Slumberland's entrance across the street. Aligning entrances on roads with center turn lanes is highly desirable. Change Order #1 was to remove Ziegler's existing entrance, install new entrance and installation of black dirt with seeding at the old entrance. Change Order #1 resulted in an addition of \$22,648.70 to the contract.

### **Analysis of Issue**

To relocate Ziegler's entrance, Mid-American had to relocate utility poles. Mid-American's fee to remove one pole and install two poles is \$6,122.81.

## **Budget Impact**

The project will be funded from Local Option Sales Tax.



## **Strategic Plan Impact**

Policy D.4.2: Advanced planning for all infrastructure facilities shall be supported and routinely updated. Facilities benefited by advanced planning shall include, at minimum, schools, health care, residential areas, roads, water, sewer, storm water management, parks, recreation, and greenways.

Policy D.4.1: Recognizing that infrastructure has a powerful influence on growth and development, the availability of infrastructure (along with other factors) should determine where development will occur in the city, rather than the other way around.

## **Impact on Existing Plans**

Fort Dodge Asphalt has completed the turn lane, asphalt, and pavement markings work. Their sub-contractor continues to work on the traffic signal installation at the east driveway of Menards.

## **Staff Conclusions / Recommendations**

It is our recommendation to approve the payment to Mid-American Energy in the amount of \$6,122.81.
