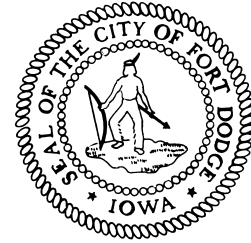

Subject: Water Plant, payment of well 17 repairs

Brief History

Pump output had dropped from the normal 1,500 gpm to less than 950 gpm.

Analysis of Issue

Amperage was checked and was down around 30%. The pump was suspected as being the problem and Northway was called to remove pump/motor to check problem. Found some pipe with bad threads along with pump bowl assembly needing replaced and repair to 200 HP motor. Estimate of work \$53,359. Final cost \$63,106.

Budget Impact

Line item in current year for well maintenance is \$100,000. This is to be paid from the Water Utility Fund.

Strategic Plan Impact

Follows Policy D.4.2 in that planning includes maintenance and repair of infrastructure, in particular raw water.
