## Fort Dodge City Council Minutes for September 8, 2014

Mayor Bemrich called meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Present: Council Members: David Flattery, Jeffrey Halter, Don Wilson, Andy Fritz, Kim Alstott, Terry Moehnke and Dean Hill.

Moved by Fritz to approve the agenda for this meeting. Motion seconded by Moehnke. Aye: 7. Nay: 0. Motion carried.

Mayor Bemrich announced that this is the time and place for a public hearing on proposed plans, specifications, form of contract and estimate of cost for the 2014 OHV Water Main Extension Project for the City of Fort Dodge, Iowa. Mayor Bemrich asked for comments, written or oral. There being none, he declared the hearing closed.

City Clerk Nemmers introduced Resolution No. 14-09-226 Approving Plans and Specifications, Form of Contract and Estimate of Cost for the 2014 OHV Water Main Extension Project for the City of Fort Dodge, Iowa. Council Member Flattery moved to adopt Resolution No. 14-09-226 as introduced. Motion seconded by Hill. On roll call, the vote was: Aye: 7. Nay: 0. Resolution was adopted.

City Clerk Nemmers introduced Resolution No. 14-09-227 Awarding Contract for the 2014 OHV Water Main Extension Project for the City of Fort Dodge, Iowa. Council Member Flattery moved to adopt Resolution No. 14-09-227 as introduced and accept bid in the amount of \$1,099,416.50 from Carstensen Contracting, Inc. Motion seconded by Alstott. On roll call, the vote was: Aye: 7. Nay: 0. Resolution was adopted.

Mayor Bemrich announced that this is the time and place for a public hearing to consider the disposal of Part of Lots 1, 2, and 3, County Auditor's Taxation Plat of Section 17-89-28 in the City of Fort Dodge, Webster County, Iowa. Mayor Bemrich asked for comments, written or oral. There being none, he declared the hearing closed.

City Clerk Nemmers introduced Resolution No. 14-09-228 Directing the Disposal of an Interest in Real Property following Public Hearing. Council Member Wilson moved to adopt Resolution No. 14-09-228 as introduced and dispose of property in the amount of \$3,000.00 to Autumn Johanson. Motion seconded by Fritz. On roll call, the vote was: Aye: 7. Nay: 0. Resolution was adopted.

Mayor Bemrich announced that this is the time and place for a public hearing to consider vacating a portion of public right-of-way described as a portion of 1st Avenue North located north of Lot 4 and Lot 3, in Block 7 of Original Town of Fort Dodge, Webster County, Iowa. Mayor Bemrich asked for comments, written or oral. There being none, he declared the hearing closed.

City Clerk Nemmers introduced first consideration of Ordinance No. 2218, an Ordinance Providing for the Vacation of Public Right-of-Way in the City of Fort Dodge, Webster County, Iowa. Council Member Wilson moved to pass on first consideration Ordinance No. 2218 as introduced. Motion seconded by Alstott. On roll call, the vote was: Aye: 7. Nay: 0. Ordinance No. 2218 passed on first consideration.

Motion seconded by Hill. On roll call, the vote was: Aye: 7. Nay: 0. Motion carried. Resolutions were adopted.

Council Member Wilson moved to approve Joint Public Services with Webster County Providing for the Division of Fees for Council Member Engineering and Construction Costs for Bridge Replacement Project FM-CO94(983370)—55-94 on 210<sup>th</sup> Street/Extension of 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue South, between Sections 28 and 33, T-89N, R-28W, Cooper Township, Webster County, Iowa. Motion seconded by Moehnke. On roll call, the vote was: Aye: 7. Nay: 0. Motion carried.

Council Member Flattery moved to adopt Resolution No. 14-09-234 Authorizing the City to Enter into Agreement with Property Owners Desiring City Services. Motion seconded by Fritz. Mr. Knupp clarified that agreement is with Clyde and Dianne Knupp and gave history of their ownership. Mandatory property setbacks, tax abatement and beautification issues were discussed by Council. Neven Mulholland, attorney for C & S Products, reported that Webster County Board of Adjustment denied the Knupps' variance application of a 25' setback. Mulholland reported that his company doesn't oppose storage units but oppose zoning violations. Zoning laws are mandated for safety of the employees, orderly development and aesthetics. Carissa Miller, Senior Planner for the City of Fort Dodge, reported that no variance would be needed for construction if annexation was approved. Clark Fletcher, 1785 Madison Avenue, representing Webster County, gave history of the County's zoning amendment in 2009 that required a 50 foot setback on the south and west sides of the property in question. On roll call, the vote was: Aye: Wilson, Moehnke and Hill. Nay: Flattery, Halter, and Fritz. Abstain: Alstott conflict of interest. Motion defeated.

Council Member Flattery moved to approve Change Order No. 5 increasing the contract in the amount of \$300.00, Pay Estimate No. 17, sub-final, in the amount of \$114,681.60 from CL Carroll Co. for the North Ag Park Expansion – Water Systems Improvements 2011, Phase A: Raw Water Supply, Section 2: Well Houses Project. Motion seconded by Fritz. On roll call, the vote was: Aye: 7. Nay: 0. Motion carried.

Council Member Flattery moved to approve Change Order No. 2 reducing the contract in the amount of \$5,000.00, Pay Estimate No. 4, final, in the amount of \$11,945.54 from Wicks Construction for the 2013 North 23<sup>rd</sup> Street Improvement Project. Motion seconded by Alstott. On roll call, the vote was: Aye:7. Nay: 0. Motion carried.

Council Member Flattery moved to approve Pay Estimate No. 7, final, in the amount of \$12,098.00 from Jensen Builders Ltd. for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue South Trail Project. Motion seconded by Alstott. On roll call, the vote was: Aye: 7. Nay: 0. Motion carried.

Council Member Flattery moved to approve Change Order No. 2 increases the contract in the amount \$32,931.19 and Pay Estimate No. 2, sub-final, in the amount of \$495,922.32 from Fort Dodge Asphalt Company for the 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue South Corridor Improvements Project. Motion seconded by Moehnke. On roll call, the vote was: Aye: 7. Nay: 0. Motion carried.

Council Member Alstott moved to approve New Taxi Cab License for First Call Taxi & Courier Service, Evansdale, Iowa. Motion seconded by Fritz. Discussion was held. On roll call, the vote was: Aye: 6. Nay: Wilson. Motion carried.

## Comments and Questions from the Public.

Clyde Knupp questioned next process since his property annexation failed. Mayor Bemrich directed Council Members to give City Manager their concerns regarding annexation. **End of Comments, etc.** 

There being no further business to come before Council, Council Member Fritz moved for adjournment. Motion seconded by Alstott. Aye: 7. Nay: 0. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:17 p.m.
